Your employer effectively buys the bike and equipment on your behalf, then leases it back to you through an interest-free salary sacrifice scheme.

HOW TO PURCHASE WITH A CYCLE TO WORK SCHEME

If you already have a voucher, just email it info@thearkcycles.co.uk and let us know what bike you would like ready for collection.

Purchasing a bike with cycle to work could not be simpler, below are step by step guides for the process both those needing to get a quote to start the process and those that already have a voucher to spend.

- The old £1000 limit has now been lifted so we can accept cycle to work vouchers for any amount
- We have to pay a fee to accept your cycle to work voucher. Where these fees are very high we do, unfortunately, have a surcharge payable. This does not apply to all cycle to work schemes but does apply to Cycle Scheme **5%**, Halfords & Cycle2Work **10%**. These percentages are applied to the amount of the voucher.
- Accessories will be charged at the website listed price and may include discounts.
- Cameras and GPS equipment are NOT permitted.
- Any Multibuy or Free Gift promotions are excluded from Cycle 2 Work orders.
